This is a regular meeting of the Police and Fire Commission of the City of Hartford. Prior to this meeting, notice was given to the public by posting an agenda on the City Office Meeting Board, Library Bulletin Board, and Police Bulletin Board. In addition, the Daily News (the official City newspaper) was given notice of this meeting and an agenda was placed in their City Office mailboxes at least 24 hours ago.

- 5) *Fire & Rescue* – No new business
- 6) *Police Department* – The Police & Fire Commission is to move into closed session pursuant to Wis. Stats. 19.85(1)(c) for the purpose of “considering employment, promotion, compensation or performance evaluation data of any public employee over which the governmental body has jurisdiction or exercises responsibility.”
  - a) Commission will interview Police Officer Candidates.
  - b) Commission will interview Police Aides for potential appointment by advantage under §62.13(4)(a).
  - c) The Commission will review Patrol Officer and Communications Officer candidate’s selection process scores.
- 7) *Police Department* – Return to open session. The Commission will vote on the following matters:
  - a) To establish an eligibility list for the position of Police Officer, and determine the duration of that list.
  - b) To confirm Chief Groves’ appointment of Officer(s) from the Police Officer Eligibility List on or after October 3, 2016, subject to successful completion of all pre-hire conditions.
  - c) To confirm Chief Groves’ appointment of Police Aide(s) to the position of Police Officer(s) on or after October 3, 2016, subject to successful completion of all pre-hire conditions.
  - d) Authorize the department to re-initiate the Communications Officer eligibility list recruitment process.
  - e) Authorize the department to begin a Police Aides eligibility list recruitment process.
