

PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE

February 26, 2019

ALSO PRESENT: City Administrator Volkert, City Engineer Schall

Call to Order – Alderperson Wintringer called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. in the Common Council Chambers of Hartford City Hall, 109 North Main Street.

Roll Call – All members of the Committee were present except Chairperson Mixon, who was absent and excused. Alternate Member Wintringer was also present.

Public Comment Period – None.

2019 Construction Projects – City Engineer Schall provided information on the 2019 construction projects, and responded to questions.

MS4 General Permit – City Engineer Schall provided information on the 2018 annual report under MS4 General Permit, and responded to questions. The report outlines the storm water activities, programs, policies and ordinances followed by the City of Hartford in order to maintain compliance with minimum measures required under the permit.

Sidewalk in Lake View Acres First Addition Subdivision – Lake View Acres First Addition was developed in 1994 and includes properties on Zuern Drive, Lake View Drive, and S Teri Lane. The original subdivider's agreement for the subdivision required sidewalk in front of all properties with a completion date of June 30, 1997 for the sidewalk installation. However, there is a note that the intent is that sidewalk would probably not be ordered unless and until it can be connected to the STH 60 bike trail. There is a small section of S Teri Lane between Lake View Acres First Addition and the STH 60 bike trail that is still in the Town of Hartford and has prevented the City from establishing a connection to the bike trail. As this does not appear to change any time soon the City should not use the connection to the bike trail to hold off sidewalk installation any longer. As a property is sold, engineering has provided notice of the sidewalk requirement in this subdivision. All property owners in the subdivision should have a record of the sidewalk requirement. If the Committee is in favor of installing the sidewalk in the subdivision, it would be included as part of the 2020 sidewalk program. City Engineer Schall provided information on the sidewalk installation, and responded to questions. It was the consensus of the Committee that the City move forward with sidewalk installation in Lake View Acres First Addition Subdivision.
