

**FINANCE & PERSONNEL COMMITTEE**

Call to Order – Chairperson Rusniak called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. in the Common Council Chambers of Hartford City Hall, 109 North Main Street.

Roll Call – All members of the Committee were present.

Public Comment Period – None.

Licenses – MOTION by Alderperson Wintringer, and seconded by Alderperson Fulop recommending to the Common Council to approve a bartender license for Arielle Messier, Sarah McGlothlin, and Sydney Mikulec. MOTION CARRIED.

Denying a Bartenders License – Colten Weber was present speaking on his behalf. Chairperson Rusniak explained that according to municipal criteria, Mr. Weber should be denied the bartenders license. Police Chief Groves clarified the criteria. Staff discussed this item.

MOTION by Alderperson Wintringer and seconded by Alderperson Kohler recommending to the Common Council to deny the bartenders license for Colten Weber. MOTION CARRIED.

Denying a Bartenders License – Daniel Sutter was present speaking on his behalf. Shirley Jost, one of the owners of B & S Liquor, spoke on Daniel's behalf.

MOTION by Alderperson Fulop recommending to the Common Council to allow Daniel Sutter to have a bartenders License. MOTION DIED.

PSLO Agreement with Hartford Joint #1 – Police Chief Groves spoke about adding a nine month police liaison for Hartford Joint #1. Staff commented on this item.

MOTION by Alderperson Fulop, seconded by Alderperson Kohler recommending to the Common Council to authorize appropriate City officials, contingent upon Hartford Joint #1 School Board approval, to enter into a part-time PSLO (Police School Liaison Officer) Agreement with the Hartford Joint #1 District and to authorize the addition of a 28<sup>th</sup> approved staffing position for a sworn police officer to accommodate the filling of this position. MOTION CARRIED.

Adjournment – MOTION by Alderperson Wintringer, and seconded by Alderperson Kohler for adjournment. MOTION CARRIED.
