- ◆ Part-Time Communications Officer David Zirbel began his tour of duty at the Hartford Police Department on April 17, 2014.


### 4.) *ANTICIPATED PROJECTS/TASKS/ACTIVITIES*

7.) **CASES OF INTEREST**

- ◆ On 04-22-14, after initially stopping a vehicle for expired registration, the K9 unit was called out to perform an exterior check of the vehicle. The K9 alerted to the vehicle. Upon further investigation, numerous items of paraphernalia used for injecting heroin were located inside the vehicle. In the trunk of the vehicle, a laundry bottle was located containing over 100 used needles. Syringes of Narcan and a small amount of heroin were also recovered from the vehicle. Charges of possession of a narcotic and possession of drug paraphernalia have been requested through the Washington County District Attorney's Office for review and prosecution against a 31-year-old Slinger man, a 31-year-old Hartford woman, and a 27-year-old Slinger man.
