- ◆ Ms. Karen Opichka was appointed to the position of part-time "floating" communications officer.


4.) ANTICIPATED PROJECTS/TASKS/ACTIVITIES

7.) **CASES OF INTEREST**

- ◆ 02-08-14, a traffic stop was conducted on a vehicle at the intersection of E. Sumner and Sell Dr. The driver admitted to using heroin approximately two hours before the stop and that she had several syringes in her purse. Several additional items of paraphernalia were located in the glovebox and several used and unused syringes were located in her purse. Along with the syringes were two blue tourniquets and multiple alcohol wipes with blood on them. The driver also had a Narcan Kit. Charges of possession of drug paraphernalia have been requested on the 24-year-old Port Washington woman. Additional criminal charges are pending test result confirmation from the crime lab on a substance that was seized from the suspect that is suspected to be heroin.
