
4.) ANTICIPATED PROJECTS/TASKS/ACTIVITIES

7.) **CASES OF INTEREST**

- ◆ 01-09-14, at approximately 10:28 a.m., Hartford officers responded to a report of an attempted robbery by a subject armed with a knife at the Petro Quick Mart, 1502 E. Sumner St., Hartford. Investigation revealed the suspect had brandished the weapon at the gas station attendant and demanded cash from the register. When the attendant refused to comply with the suspect's demands, the suspect fled without obtaining any money. The suspect fled the scene on foot prior to police arrival. While checking the area for the suspect, officers observed a male matching the suspect's description leaving the area in a vehicle at a high rate of speed. When officers attempted to stop the vehicle, the driver attempted to elude the officers. The suspect then led officers on a brief, high-speed pursuit before crashing his vehicle into a guard rail in the 100 block of South St. The crash disabled the suspect's vehicle. He abandoned it and attempted to flee on foot. Officers were able to take the suspect into custody in the 100 block of E. Sumner St. without further incident. No one was injured in this incident. Charges of Attempted Armed Robbery, Recklessly Endangering Safety, Eluding, and Resisting an Officer were referred to the Washington County District Attorney's Office against the 28-year-old Hartford man.
