- ◆ Part-Time Communications Officer Sandra Sermersheim began her tour of duty at the Hartford Police Department on March 25, 2014.


4.) *ANTICIPATED PROJECTS/TASKS/ACTIVITIES*

- ◆ Many employees attended in-house AED/CPR recertification training

(Note: Staffing was functionally one positions below our authorized levels in the Patrol Division due to a prolonged medical leave and one part-time communications position short due to a resignation. Additionally, overtime hours that had been budgeted for squad conversions were worked in March.)

7.) **CASES OF INTEREST**

- ◆ On 03/26/14, officers were dispatched to a residence on the city's south side for a report of an 18-year-old female who was not breathing and not responsive due to a possible heroin overdose. Prior to officers arrival, a resident of the home administered Narcan to the individual and they resumed breathing and became semi-coherent. Ultimately, a search warrant for the residence was obtained and executed. Officers recovered 32 used needles, two used Narcan needles, and several metal tins with white powder that tested positive for heroin. Charges of possession of heroin and possession of drug paraphernalia have been requested on two individuals in the residence.
