- ◆ The H.P.D. Color Guard made their first appearance at the Hartford Christmas Parade in November.




4.) ANTICIPATED PROJECTS/TASKS/ACTIVITIES

7.) CASES OF INTEREST

- ◆ On 11-22-14, investigation at the scene of a routine traffic stop led to the recovery of multiple individually packaged quantities of marijuana and charges against a 26-year-old Milwaukee man for Possession with Intent to Deliver THC. A second occupant of the vehicle, a 22-year-old Milwaukee man, was also arrested and taken into custody for an outstanding arrest warrant as well as Possession with Intent to Deliver THC and Pandering. The third occupant of the vehicle, a 19-year-old Milwaukee woman, was also arrested on a Prostitution charge. Follow-up investigation lead to the arrest of an additional subject, a 20-year-old Hartford man, who was not in the vehicle at the time of the traffic stop, for Prostitution.
