- ◆ The department will monitor our downtown's annual Maxwell Street Days event


5.) TRAINING

7.) *CASES OF INTEREST*

- ◆ 06-25-15, officers responded to the 600 block of E. Lincoln Ave. for a report of a known burglary suspect exiting a vehicle to hide in the bushes and behaving suspiciously. Investigation at the scene lead to the subject, a 24-year-old Hartford man, being arrested for charges of trespassing and carrying a concealed weapon. Further investigation determined that the there were two subjects in the vehicle associated with the suspicious subject. The 43-year-old and 58 year-old Milwaukee men, both convicted felons, were found to be in possession of a knife and .22 caliber semiautomatic handgun. Charges against all three individuals have been refered to the Washington County District Attorney’s Office for review and prosecution.
