



Dear Chief Groves-

We have been meaning to write this letter for some time now and regret having not had the chance to do so earlier. It's an important and overdue recognition.

My wife, Jane, and I have had the pleasure of getting to know and be associated with Sergeant James Zywicki in his capacity as Advisor to your Hartford Police Explorer post which has been in existence for several years now. We also have the distinct good fortune of having our son, [REDACTED], be a member of that same Explorer post for this, his third year.

It's a little hard to know where to start with this letter. Jim has had such a positive impact in so many areas and on so many young lives as leader of the Hartford Explorers. He has assisted in shaping young men's and women's ethics and core values, he's helped instill in them honesty and integrity, he's provided a firm yet genuine discipline, and he has gently persuaded a spirit of volunteerism into a group of teenagers whose lives, in today's day, have a significant amount of negative influence coming at them from every direction.


Our son, [REDACTED], has gained tremendously from Jim's guidance and direction. He has grown in confidence and has matured as a young adult, clearly showing some of the influence Jim has provided him over these last several years. We see the same in so many of your Explorers. They conduct themselves with integrity, both in as well as outside of Jim's presence, and they're able to set examples for their peers we all can be very proud of.

The commitment Jim makes to these young adults never ceases to amaze us. The amount of time he puts into leading and directing these Explorers is simply exceptional. Much of that time is spent as their lead instructor and guide, teaching them the ins and outs of the most detailed issues of professional law enforcement. And at other times it requires that he relegate himself nearly to child care over a group of somewhat unruly teenagers that realistically, at this age, can't be expected to be adults all the time. Yet he doesn't step away from any aspect of it. He makes himself totally available to them for any issue they might be faced with, at any time.

The post's national recognition for volunteer hours illustrates only too clearly how much time and effort Jim has put into making this group of Explorers a model for other posts looking to build theirs in a similar fashion. And it would be remiss of us not to commend you personally for your support of all Jim's efforts to make this post what it is, to allow this all to be possible. Without your unending commitment to the goals of the post and your flexibility in allowing Jim to put in 'company time' to accomplish all he's done, this team wouldn't be what it has become today.

Jane and I are exceedingly impressed with Sergeant Zywicki and the team of Explorers he has assembled and nurtured over these years, and all their accomplishments. We are exceptionally proud to tell anyone who will listen that our son is a member of the Hartford Police Explorers, one of the best Explorer posts you could possibly want to find. Please accept our heartfelt thanks to Sergeant Zywicki, and to you, Chief Groves, for your special commitment to all their efforts and success.



Thank you for the City's continued efforts in keeping our students and schools safe.




Dear Sergeant Zywicki-


