Recently, I was one of two explorers in the Hartford Police Explorer Post 9910 to have the opportunity to go to one of the Federal Law Enforcement Leadership Academies. I attended the United States Marshals Leadership Academy in Washington D.C. at the expense of the Hartford Police Explorer Post. I was selected along with 29 other Law Enforcement Explorers from all over the United States to attend the U.S. Marshals Leadership Academy. There was a total of approximately 300 applications for this academy alone.


I just wanted to take the time to say thank you for the opportunity to attend this academy. Without your support and approval, I would never have had the opportunity to experience such a great program. I learned a lot during my week in D.C. and I am extremely grateful to you for your support in sending me there.

During the week of the academy, I received training on several different aspects of the Marshals Service including Protective Service Detail and K9 Explosive Detection. I was also exposed to many other aspects of the Marshals Service including Special Operations Groups, Protective Intelligence, and Forfeitures and Seizures. In addition to U.S. Marshals training, we were also given tours and training on other federal law enforcement agencies. We toured the U.S. Park Police, A.T.F.E., U.S. Secret Service, Supreme Court Police, and the Capitol Police. In addition to these tours, we went to the Federal Law Enforcement Training Center (FLETC) for Emergency Vehicle Operation and Control training along with firearms training. In addition to training we met with U.S. Army CID Officers, toured Washington D.C., learned and exercised leadership skills, and met with several key people in the U.S. Marshals Organization including the Director. I also met 29 other Law Enforcement Explorers from all over the United States ranging from California to New York to even Puerto Rico. I made some great friends during that week, as well as establishing contacts with many other explorer agencies across the United States.

This week really opened me up to the federal side of law enforcement. I was also able to develop a better sense of leadership that I intend to bring back to the Hartford Post. I also will be looking forward to instilling my week's training on them to open them up to participating in one of the National Leadership Academies in two years.


Dear Sergeant Zywicki-




