

CURBSIDE RECYCLING – BI-WEEKLY

(1-4 Family Buildings)

Place Recycling Cart (**Yellow Cover**) out bi-weekly on your regular garbage day; co-mingle items as follows:

- Cardboard/newspaper/magazines
- Aluminum & bi-metal cans (rinse & crush)
- Steel (tin) cans (no aerosol)
- Glass (brown, green & clear – rinse) no lids
- Plastic containers – SPI Code # 1 – 7
(includes milk, water, soda & detergent)

RECYCLING CENTER DROP-OFF

Deliver the following items to the City Recycling Center:

- Lead acid **batteries** (car batteries)
- **Waste Oil** & Antifreeze
- Yard and garden waste, apples & pumpkins
- **Grass clippings** and roots
- **Leaves** (*except during October & November*)
- **Cardboard-flattened**
- **Metal items** (Appliances, bikes, grills, exercise equipment, lawnmowers, snowblowers, bed frames, etc.)
- **Co-mingled Glass, Plastic, Tin & Metal Cans** in clear plastic bags
- **Tires** (no rims); **\$5.00/ tire**
- **TVs & Computers** (all sizes) - **\$20.00/each**
(Flat screens are accepted free of charge)

CURBSIDE GARBAGE PICKUP

(1-3 Family Buildings)

AUTOMATED CURBSIDE COLLECTION OF GARBAGE BY ADVANCED DISPOSAL 4 DAY COLLECTION from MON – THURS

Weekly Collection of Solid Waste in approved contractor supplied CARTS must be placed curbside by 7:00 a.m. on your regularly scheduled collection day. GARBAGE AND RECYCLING CARTS SHOULD:

- FACE STREET WITH HANDLES AWAY FROM STREET
- BE PLACED 3 FEET AWAY FROM OTHER CART
- HAVE COVER CLOSED
- MATERIAL NEXT TO CART WILL NOT BE COLLECTED
- CART CANNOT BE BLOCKED BY PARKED VEHICLES



- * **Carts are the property of Advanced Disposal**
- * **When you move out, CARTS stay with the Home**

• FALL LEAF PICKUP – Raked loose leaves will be picked up along the curb GUTTER from approximately October 15th to November 25th, except after permanent snowfall. Do not mix BRANCHES OR PUMPKINS with leaves curbside. At all other times bag your leaves and take them to the Recycling Center during hours of operation. **NO CURBSIDE PICKUP IN SPRING.**

• TRAILER Rental: Concrete, Dirt, Rocks & Gravel-type material can be disposed of using a City Trailer. Rental fee is \$20.00 per load payable at the City Hall Cashier's

counter. Reserve Trailer overnight or over the weekend – call 673-8261.

FRIDAY BULK ITEM PICKUP: Schedule your Friday bulky NON-METAL garbage pickup when purchasing your \$15.00 green sticker at the Finance Cashier's counter at City Hall and sign up leaving your address, phone number and the name of items you want picked up.

(Call 673-8261 or 673-8225 with questions). Examples of Bulk items include:

Mattress/box set, carpet/pad (per room), couch, recliner, wooden furniture, toilet, sink, 3 doors or windows per sticker, glass shower doors, countertops, plastic water softener, hot tubs, wooden desks, cabinets, dressers, 2 x 4 lumber, railroad ties, plastic pools, and 10-12 bags of excessive garbage, etc.

• PAINT CANS: Latex and oil-based paint can be disposed of by drying out paint in the can or pouring it out in layers on newspaper, cardboard or kitty litter. Dried paint cans and material can then be thrown in garbage cart.

APPLIANCE PICKUP: \$15.00 for curbside pickup of metal appliances or \$20.00 for curbside pickup of tube TVs. Schedule your pickup when you pay the fee at the CASHIER'S COUNTER at City Hall – top floor.

BRUSH PICKUP: DO NOT BRING BRUSH TO RECYCLING CENTER; DO NOT PLACE BRUSH ON ROADWAY; place cut and broken branches, shrubs and evergreens between the curb and sidewalk on the first full work week of each month (Monday – Friday) (regardless if it includes a holiday) by 7:00 a.m. on your regular garbage pickup day. Take **ROOTS** to the Recycling Center. Place brush facing in one direction; do not cut branches. Branches are limited to a maximum of 10-inch diameter. Dispose of larger sizes privately.

BRUSH WEEKS: Jan. 4 – 8; Feb. 1 – 5; Mar. 7 – 11; Apr. 4 – 8; May 2 – 6; June 6 – 10; July 4 – 8; Aug. 1 – 5; Sept. 5 – 9; Oct. 3 – 7; Nov. 7 – 11; Dec. 5 - 9
