DISPOSAL OF ALL TVs AND COMPUTER MONITORS

<u>WHY:</u> Wisconsin Act 50 banned electronic devices from Wisconsin Landfills in 2009; Goodwill Stores discontinued accepting tube TVs on December 1, 2014

WHAT DOES THE CITY OFFER? A drop-off site at the **Recycling Center** for all TVs and Computer Monitors which are then picked up by Legacy Recycling (currently at \$25.00 per TV or Monitor). They process them through their R2 certified facilities so they will not end up in a landfill. YOU MUST BE A CITY OF HARTFORD RESIDENT TO DROP OFF TVs & MONITORS AT THE RECYCLING CENTER. They also accept other small electronics such as CPU's, Laptops, Printers, Fax Machines, Keyboards and Phones at no charge.

<u>CURRENT COST:</u> **\$25.00** per Tube TV or Computer Monitor (Includes Curbside or Recycling Center Drop Off). All sizes are **included – Even Flat Screen TVs and Computer Monitors.** <u>Cost is subject to change if City's contractor increases their charge to City.</u>

<u>CURBSIDE PICKUP:</u> If your TV is too large/heavy for transporting to the Recycling Center, City residents can schedule a Friday curbside pick-up. The cost is \$25.00; a **YELLOW STICKER** which must be purchased at the Finance Counter at City Hall before 4:15 pm on Thursdays is needed in order to get curbside pickup scheduled for Fridays. You sign up when you purchase the sticker. Call 673-8225 with questions.
