

The Hartford Police Department is accredited by the Wisconsin Law Enforcement Accreditation Group (WILEAG). After an excess of a decade of preparation, on October 26, 2018 the WILEAG Governing Board voted unanimously to Accredite the Hartford Police Department, effective immediately.

What is accreditation?

Accreditation refers to a system of rules and regulations, called “Standards,” that an agency is to follow in order to retain the status of being “accredited.” Colleges, universities, health care providers and school districts are commonly accredited.

What does it mean to be accredited?

- Promotes excellence and professionalism within law enforcement through voluntary compliance with Wisconsin Law Enforcement Accreditation Group standards.
- Assurance and confidence that your agency is in compliance with all state mandated policies.
- Confidence, by virtue of outside assessors, that your agency is in compliance and functioning through state approved practices and procedures.
- Access to model policies and procedures in the State of Wisconsin.
- Network with other professional organizations.
- May experience increased savings with insurance costs.
