On Tuesday, December 13 , 2011, the Hartford Police Department recognized the individuals and organizations that had played an important role in meeting the fundraising objectives of the department’s “Cash for Cash” program. Each of these individuals and the organizations they represent contributed between \$500 and \$10,000 toward making the police K-9 program a reality here in Hartford.

Unlike most communities that raise funding for these types of projects exclusively through large corporate donations, Hartford’s goals have been met by these individuals, their organizations, our civic organizations, and everyone who dropped some change in one of our fundraising doghouses over the last 10 months. The fundraising goal for this portion of the project was met and surpassed by a remarkably diverse cross section of our community!

The Hartford Police Department has now received a \$45,000.00 matching grant from the Windhover Foundation at Hartford Quad Graphics.
