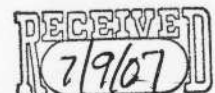
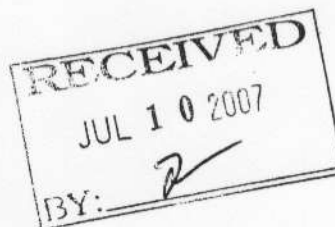
Thought you'd appreciate a note about the efficiency of your two patrolmen this past Sunday, July 1st, at approximately 8:45 a.m.

When I came out, I looked for the receipt, but there wasn't any. I figured it was out of paper, which happens sometimes. There was a squad car parked near the driveway as we left. We entered my rental complex, got the Saturday's mail, and headed around back to the garage. There was a parked squad car, and as we passed, the lights went on. We backed the car and the officer said we had not paid for our gas.

Well, we ironed out the problem immediately, and we headed back to the station to pay inside. (My sister said she swiped her card, but with the reflection of the sun, it was difficult to read the directions. As nothing happened, she hit "enter". The gas flowed and all was well.... we thought.) The point of this letter is to tell you that the officers' demeanor was firm and businesslike, which we both appreciated.
