6.) OVERTIME OCCURRING DURING THE MONTH.

7.) CASES OF INTEREST THIS MONTH.

- ◆ **Jan. 5, 2007** A 26-year-old Hartford man was arrested for operating a motor vehicle after revocation, operating with a suspended registration, possession of marijuana, possession of drug paraphernalia and two outstanding warrants. The search incident to arrest discovered two grams of marijuana, along with a pipe.

- ◆ **Jan. 14, 2008** Hartford Officers took a Hartford juvenile into custody for endangering safety, disorderly conduct and damage to property. His sister, another juvenile, was also taken into custody and is being charged with endangering safety and disorderly conduct. Officers were dispatched to the 100 block of W State St for a report that boy was shooting a BB gun at a residence. As the officer arrived, he observed the above male subject hanging out the window, still shooting at the residence. A vehicle, waiting at a stop sign at N. Rural St and W. State St, also had its windshield shot at, causing two holes. Officers learned that other reports of damaged property in other areas of the city may be linked to this group. Officers were advised that the gun used in the other complaints was discarded in the Mill Pond near the footbridge. That gun was recovered and inventoried along with the weapon used in this complaint.

- ◆ **Jan. 17, 2008** Officers were called to the McDonald's Restaurant at approximately 0021 hours for a vehicle in the drive-thru in which the occupants smelled of alcohol. A traffic stop was performed on the vehicle. The driver had a warrant issued by Chenequa Police Dept. A search of the vehicle turned up a small amount of marijuana and a pot pipe on his person. The driver was cited for possession of marijuana and possession of drug paraphernalia. The passengers were all cited for possession/consumption of intoxicant by underage person.
