- ◆ Link for public information on the H1N1 Flu ("Swine Flu") from the CDC was posted on our department's website in both English and Spanish

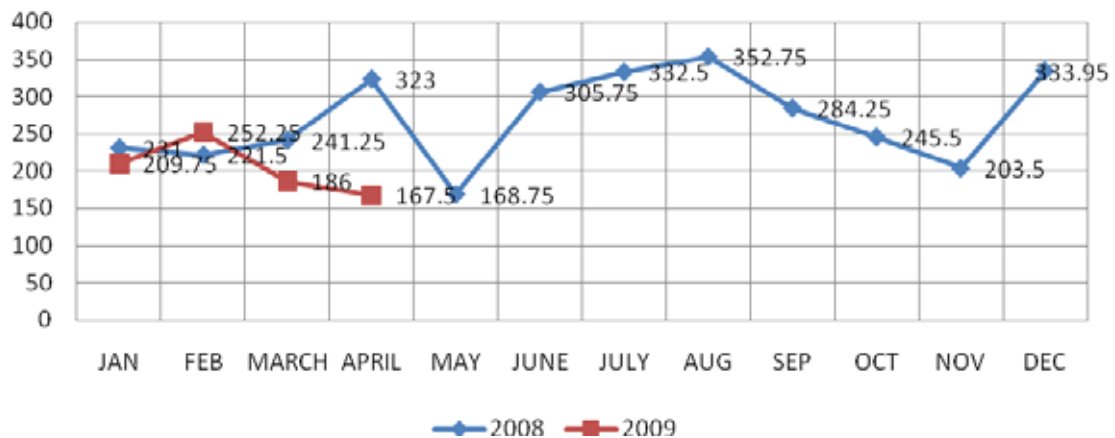
4.) ANTICIPATED PROJECTS/TASKS/ACTIVITIES

7.) **CASES OF INTEREST THIS MONTH.**

- ◆ On 04-15-09, at approximately 10:19 p.m., Hartford Officers were dispatched to the parking lot of the Broan-Nutone Company for a report of individuals going through cars in the parking lot. Upon their arrival the subjects fled, but they were ultimately apprehended. Investigation into this matter resulted in the arrests of two Hartford residents, the clearing of multiple theft from vehicle complaints that had occurred that night as well as the weekend before, and the recovery of a substantial amount of stolen property. The suspects have been referred to the Washington County District Attorney's Office on multiple charges of theft.
- ◆ On 04-20-09, as a result of a traffic stop by the department's new Traffic Narcotics Team (TNT), a 22-year-old Hartford man was arrested for operating while suspended and possession of marijuana. His passenger, a 22-year-old Rubicon man, was also arrested for possession of marijuana.
