4.) ANTICIPATED PROJECTS/TASKS/ACTIVITIES

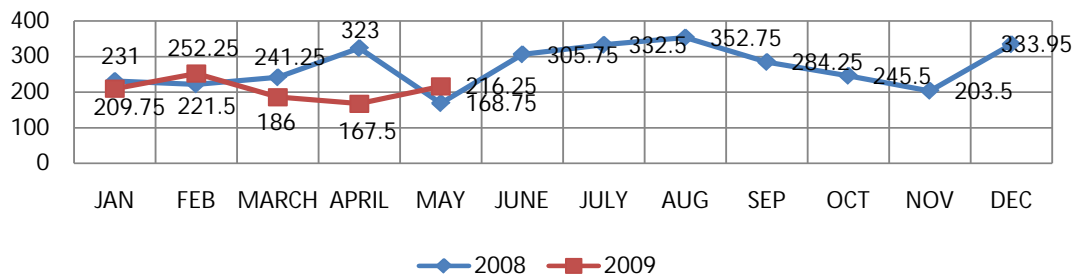
- ◆ Work will begin on the 2010 budget process

7.) CASES OF INTEREST THIS MONTH.

- ◆ On 05-19-09, a 21-year-old Rubicon woman was cited for theft. The woman was employed at the Wal-Mart store when she had taken a total of \$100 from various registers in the store.
- ◆ On 05-30-09, at approximately 6:42am, Hartford officers responded to the area of St. Kilian's Parkway and Settlement Rd. for a report of a vehicle that struck a garage at that location. Investigation at the scene revealed that the driver had been traveling west on St. Kilian's Parkway when they lost control, crossed the oncoming traffic lanes, and struck a tree. They continued on through some yards, crossed Settlement Rd, struck a parked vehicle, and became lodged between a garage and a retaining wall. Investigation at the scene resulted in the arrest of two 18-year-old Hartford men for OWI, and Underage Possession/Consumption of Intoxicants.
