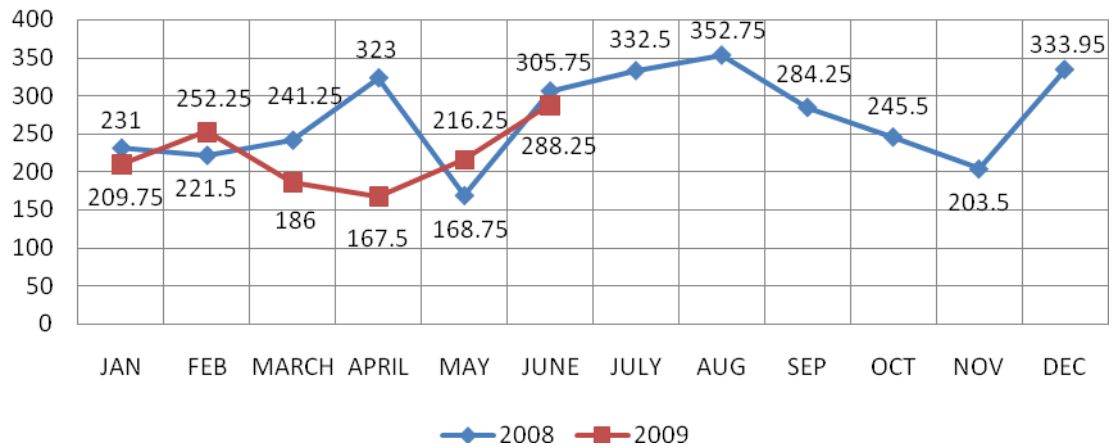
### 4.) ANTICIPATED PROJECTS/TASKS/ACTIVITIES

7.) **CASES OF INTEREST THIS MONTH.**

- ◆ 06-01-09, a 27-year-old West Bend man was arrested on charges of theft and obstructing an officer. The suspect had entered numerous vehicles on Church St., removing several items from them. The subject initially gave a false name to the officers, but was later identified correctly at the Washington County Jail.
- ◆ 06-06-09, while performing a traffic stop, officers noticed a strong odor of marijuana coming from a vehicle. Investigation at the scene resulted in the arrest of a 31-year-old Milwaukee woman for possession of marijuana and possession of drug paraphernalia. Officers seized one baggie containing 1.14 grams and a second baggie containing 4.58 grams of marijuana. The driver of the vehicle, a 30-year-old Milwaukee man, was cited also for Operating While Suspended.
- ◆ 06-12-09, a 23-year-old Hartford man was cited for receiving stolen property. Officers found the suspect to be in possession of numerous street/highway signs that belonged to the City of Hartford and the Washington County Highway Department.
