- ◆ HPD staff participated in the 2010 "Snowed in at the Movies" Program

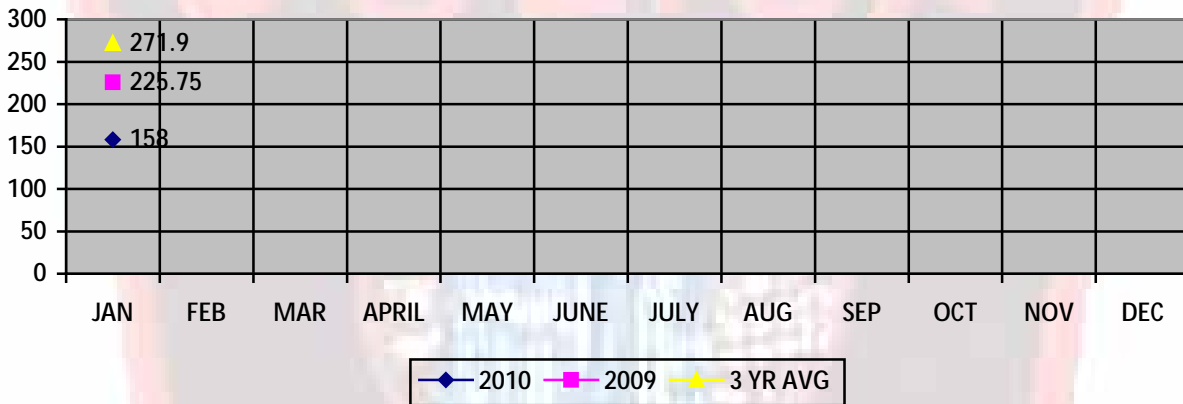
### 4.) ANTICIPATED PROJECTS/TASKS/ACTIVITIES
