This comes as no surprise to us here at HPD, and that is why we are **“COMMUNITY PROUD!”**

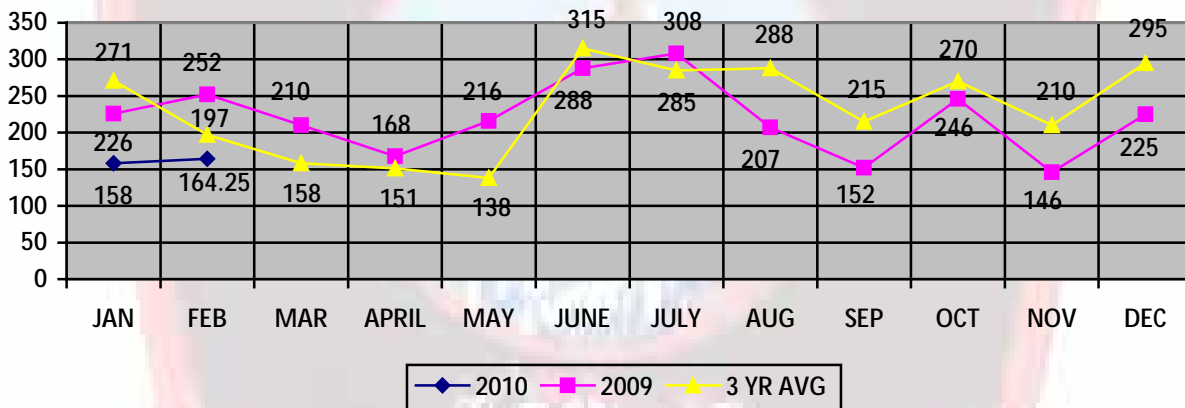
4.) **ANTICIPATED PROJECTS/TASKS/ACTIVITIES**

- ◆ Phases IV through VI of the patrol officer recruitment process will be completed.
- ◆ Based on Sergeant Fuiten's anticipated April retirement, we will begin the competitive selection process to fill the Sergeant's position he will be vacating.
- ◆ The 2010 Hartford Police Department's Mini-Academy will be offered next month. **We are anticipating 400 to 500 local, state, and federal law enforcement officers from around the state to be in attendance to train with our officers.** This year's academy will feature a forensics presentation by Dr. Henry Lee giving a presentation on Crime Scene Reconstruction, legal update modules from statewide experts in their fields, modules on prescription drug abuse investigations and interdiction techniques, and one of the F.B.I. Academy's most popular courses in Quantico, VA, Forensic Statement Analysis.

7.) **CASES OF INTEREST THIS MONTH.**

- ◆ 02-02-10, charges of theft, resisting, disorderly conduct, and two counts of bail jumping were filed on a 23-year-old Hartford man after a Hartford officer witnessed the suspect entering a vehicle parked on Mill St. When the officer approached the subject, they proceeded to flee. The subject was located, taken into custody, and it was determined he removed a stereo faceplate from the parked vehicle he had entered.
