3.) ACCOMPLISHED PROJECTS/TASKS/ACTIVITIES

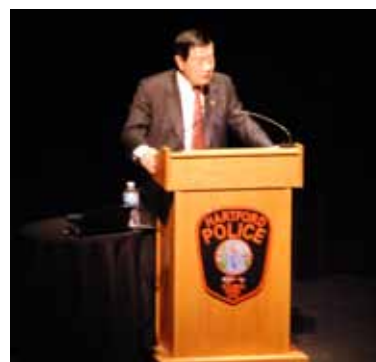
- ◆ Completed Patrol Officer Eligibility Process

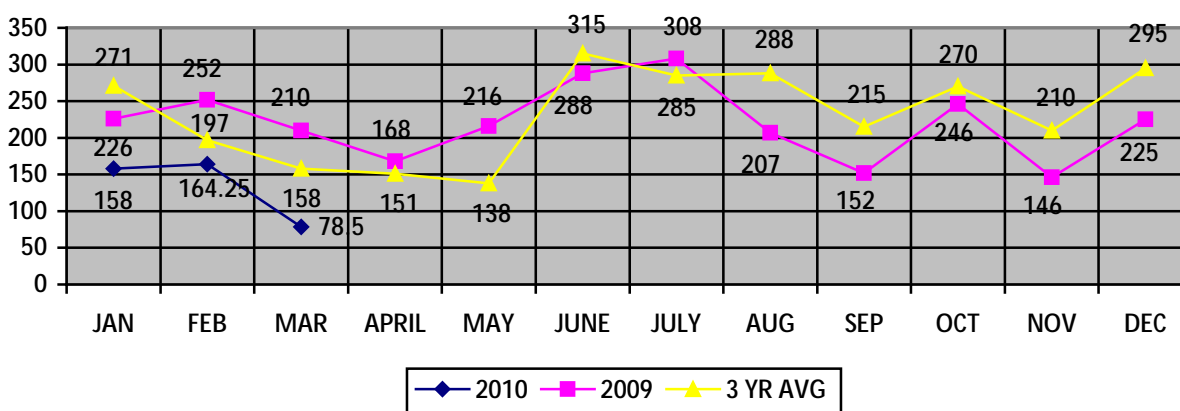
