- ◆ A new sergeant will be promoted and will assume command of second shift at 2:00pm on Monday, May 17, 2010.

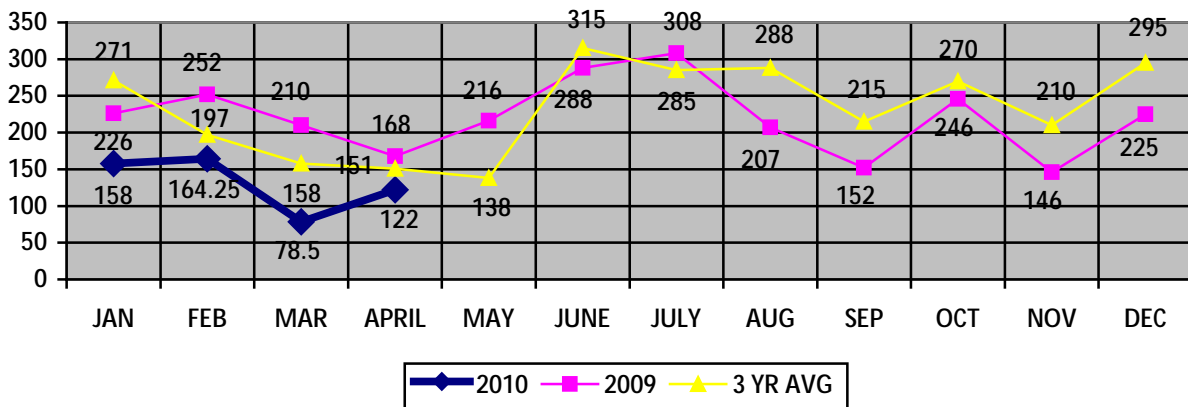

- ◆ 04-05-10, charges of attempted 1st degree homicide were referred to the Washington County District Attorney's Office against a 42-year-old Milwaukee man. The suspect was involved in an altercation with a co-worker at WB Place/Tasman Leather. The suspect pulled a knife out of his boot and stated, "This is what you've been looking for." He began swinging the knife at the victim's face, cutting him across the bridge of his nose through the cartilage. The Attempted Homicide charge was not issued by the district attorney's office, but several felony charges were filed for the subjects actions in this incident.
