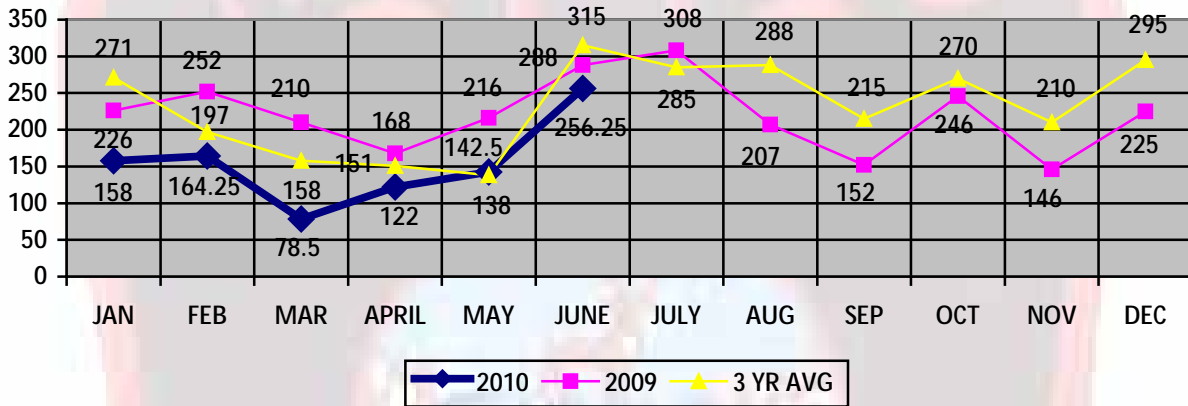


become the second Hartford Police Officer to earn an American Red Cross Hero Award.

7.) **CASES OF INTEREST**

- ◆ On 06-06-10, officers responded to the 300 block of White Eagle Ct. for a report of an underage drinking party. A 16-year-old Slinger juvenile was arrested for underage consumption and possession of drug paraphernalia. The owner of the residence, a 49-year-old Hartford man, was cited for permitting underage consumption. Officers had responded to the residence earlier in the evening for a report of an upcoming underage drinking party at the home that night, and the Hartford man was warned that he would be cited if he allowed that on his property.
- ◆ On 06-08-10 and 06-10-10, charges of burglary were filed against a 16-year-old Hartford juvenile after he cut several window screens on a garage on E. Loos St. and entered to remove a partially full carton of cigarettes. The same suspect was charged in another incident on E. Loos St. In that incident, the suspect entered an open window of a residence and took numerous rare coins, bills, and stamps. The majority of the property was returned to the owner.
- ◆ On 06-28-10, a 52-year-old Hartford man was arrested for engaging in a lewd and lascivious act in the women's undergarment department at the K-Mart store. The suspect posted bond and was released to await a future court appearance.
