- ◆ In 2011, we have experienced gas prices that have far exceeded our anticipated annual budgetary expenses for fuel. Due to that fact, we have temporarily adjusted our strategic approach to service delivery in a variety of ways. This was done in an attempt to mitigate the amount of fuel that is required to operate our fleet and help offset those unanticipated expenses. We are pleased to report that the 2011 mileage total was the lowest (by 4,500 miles) in the past five years, and over 11,500 miles less than the 2010 fleet mileage.
- ◆ It should also be noted that we did not sacrifice the “Every Street – Every Day” patrol initiative to obtain these reductions in 2011.

4.) **ANTICIPATED PROJECTS/TASKS/ACTIVITIES**



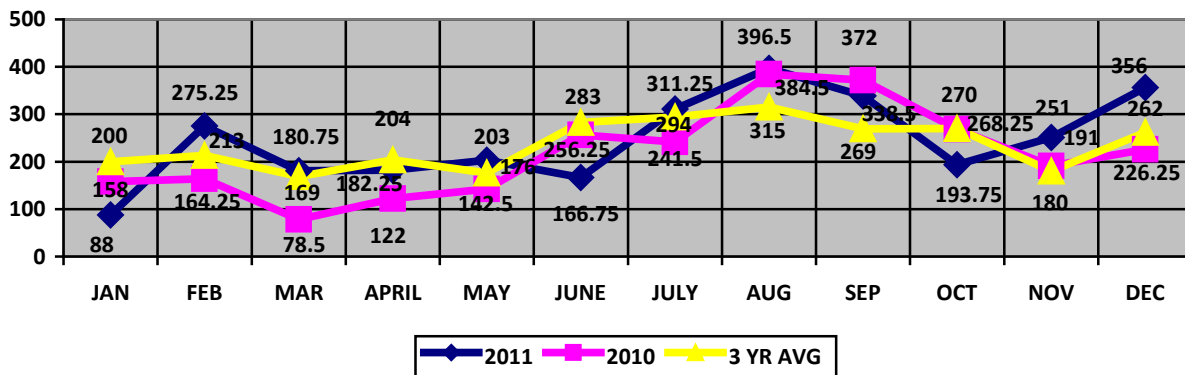
