

Note: The following information is subject to change without notice. For the latest information on obtaining a temporary license plate please contact the Hartford Police Department by calling (262) 673-2600 from 7:00 am to 2:30 pm Monday thru Friday.

The Hartford Police Department is now an authorized Department of Transportation agent for the issuing of temporary license plates. These plates may be obtained Monday through Friday from 7:00 am to 2:30 pm. These temporary plates are valid for 90 days.

TEMPORARY LICENSE PLATES CAN ONLY BE ISSUED FOR AUTOMOBILES AND LIGHT TRUCKS.

Temporary plates can **ONLY** be issued to vehicles that are being registered. Registration, title, and all other fees associated with registering a vehicle must be paid before the issuance of a temporary plate.

In order to obtain a temporary license plate, the following are needed:

1) **Title**. Must be signed by previous owner(s). If multiple owners are listed on the title with the conjunction "*and*", then all owners must sign. If the conjunction "*or*" is used, only one owner must sign.

2) **Odometer statement** if the vehicle is ten or more model years old.

3) **Lien Release** for each lien listed on the front of the title

4) Complete and accurate **Wisconsin Title and License Plate Application, MV1 or MV5**. (Available at the lobby)

5) **Check or money order** payable to Registration Fee Trust for total amount of fees.

6) **Separate check or money order** payable to the City of

Hartford for \$5.00 for our agent service fee.
