Is Your Child Restrained Properly?

Most crashes occur close to home on roads with low speed limits. When used correctly, car seats can prevent injuries and save lives. Always secure your child properly in the correct restraint. The back seat is the safest place for your child. While air bags can save lives, kids riding in the front seat can be seriously injured or killed when an air bag comes out in a crash. Children 12 and under should always sit in the back seat.
