This is a regular meeting of the Police and Fire Commission of the City of Hartford.   - a) Commission will review the Operations Lieutenant’s candidate’s selection process scores.
  - b) Commission will review the Communications Officer’s candidate’s selection process scores.
- 7) *Police Department* – Return to open session. The Commission will vote on the following matters:
  - a) To adopt a Communications Officer’s eligibility list to be in effect for a period of six months.
  - b) To confirm Chief Groves’ appointment of permanent part-time Communications Officers from the eligibility list on or after October 17, 2016.
  - c) To confirm Chief Groves’ appointment of an Operations Lieutenant, effective on or after March 4, 2017.
  - d) To confirm Chief Groves’ appointment of an Acting Sergeant from the current Sergeant’s eligibility list, effective on or after January 1, 2017.
  - e) To confirm Chief Groves’ appointment of an Acting Sergeant from the current Sergeant’s eligibility list, effective on or after March 4, 2017.
