Kohler is currently holds a Firefighter I and Hazard Material Operations Level Certifications. **Wolff** holds WI EMT Basic License, Firefighter I, Firefighter II, Driver/Operator Pumper, Driver/Operator Aerial, and Hazardous Materials Operations Level Certifications. Both have gone through through the interview process and their employment status is now pending the commission's approval and the successful completion of a pre-employment physical exam and background investigation.
