EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

TITLE: WPDES Permit-WI-S050075-3 Compliance Update – October 2023

BACKGROUND: The City of Hartford municipal stormwater permit expires on 10/31/2023. The permit establishes certain compliance obligations including Total Maximum Daily Load (TMDL) criteria requiring removal of solids and phosphorus from the stormwater discharges to the Rubicon River and other wetlands.

The City of Hartford is required to provide a compliance update associated with Permit Condition A.5.2. and the related conditions established in section A.6.3 of the permit. Specifically, the City of Hartford is reporting status related to:

- Projects listed in our approved plan that are not completed, status of the project and reasons for the delay.
- A revised Implementation plan for the next permit term, including the projects we submitted with the last plan and/or potential alternatives.

As a result of project financing, coordination and permitting interruptions to the progress of planned compliance projects, the City of Hartford will not achieve compliance with the permit conditions prior to permit expiry on October 31, 2023. WDNR anticipates they will issue the City's new stormwater discharge permit in the Summer of 2024. Until a new permit is issued, staff will continue to pursue completion of the projects that are expected to provide compliance established within the expiring permit.


