

## **PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE**

**September 28, 2021**

**6:45pm**

PRESENT: Alderpersons Hegy, Carroll, Sikora, and Webb

ALSO PRESENT: City Administrator Volkert, City Engineer John Griffin

Call to Order – Alderperson Hegy called the meeting to order at 6:45 p.m. in the Common Council Chambers of Hartford City Hall, 109 North Main Street.

Roll Call – All members of the Committee were present.

Public Comment Period – No public comment.

Update and discussion on current infrastructure projects – City Engineer John Griffin explained current projects, which included:

- Work on the annex building is complete, along with the sanitary sewer at Hilldale and Lee Rd, which will lead to three properties being connected to the city service.
- 42 inch sanitary intercept lining is complete.
- Landfill monitoring is ongoing, with the DNR attending the next sample date of October 11 at Independence Park.
- Annual sidewalk replacement program is complete.
- Sealcoat and asphalt overlay programs are complete.
- Lincoln Ave construction is complete, save for a few punch list items.
- Mill Pond bulkhead wall replacement and pedestrian bridge replacement are in progress, but DNR permits are delaying the project.
- Railroad signs and painting are complete except for work that is supposed to be completed by the railroad company.
- Harrison St construction is still in design.
- MS4 storm water project will be completed next week. Solids and phosphorus levels are still well within the permit levels.
- Crack sealing on Hwy 60 will take place on Wednesday, September 29 with help from Washington County Highway Department.
- Crack sealing on bridges will be taken care of before the weather changes.
- Lake View Acres sidewalk phase 1 is in progress. The contractor for the project has concerns for getting the actual construction started this year, given the time of year already.
- Work has not progressed at 28 S Main St., due to waiting for the Brownfield Grant to be engaged. Washington County has the grant from the EPA, but a consultant is still being chosen to complete the wells and take samples.
- Harker Ave design will be completed this month.

Discussion and consideration of approving a resolution revising ATV/UTV routes in the City of Hartford – City Engineer Griffin explained that this resolution is to add approximately 100 yards on Hwy K just south of E Sumner St, to allow access to the filling station.
