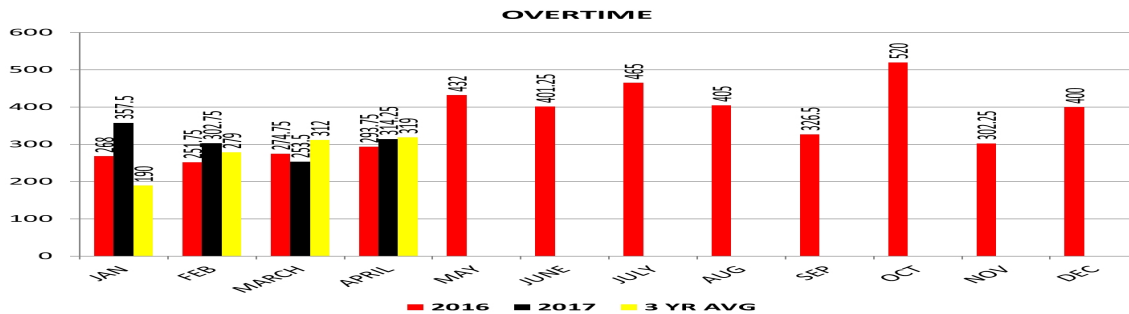
- ◆ Officer's Robert St. Onge and Amanda Naukkari will begin their tours of duty in May.
