- ◆ The 2018 Citizens Academy will kick off in August.

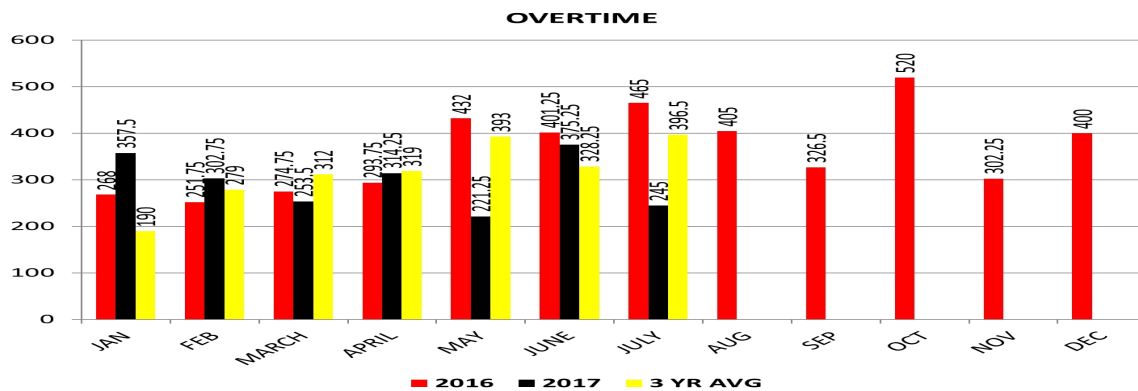

6.) OVERTIME



(Note: In July, one officer remained in the Field Training Program and was not counted for staffing coverage purposes. The 2017 Patrol Division Overtime hours are 42% below the 2016 total, and Investigations Bureau hours are down 59%. As of the end of July, our total annual departmental overtime hours are down by 14% from this time in 2016. The restoration of staffing levels will continue to stabilize our overtime requirements.)
