The suspect in the theft received **\$2,073 in fines** for Theft, Damage to Property, and Obstructing an Officer for his role in this incident. **Restitution for over \$3,300** in expenses for the dive team and the pumping of the retention pond are also being sought from the court. The suspect's **mother also received \$1,382 in citations** for Receiving Stolen Property and Obstructing the investigating officers. The hat is currently being professionally restored.
- ◆ Officer Mitch Kraemer, U.S. Army Veteran, led the Hartford City Christmas Parade.
- ◆ HPD instituted the House of Worship Security Program in local churches.

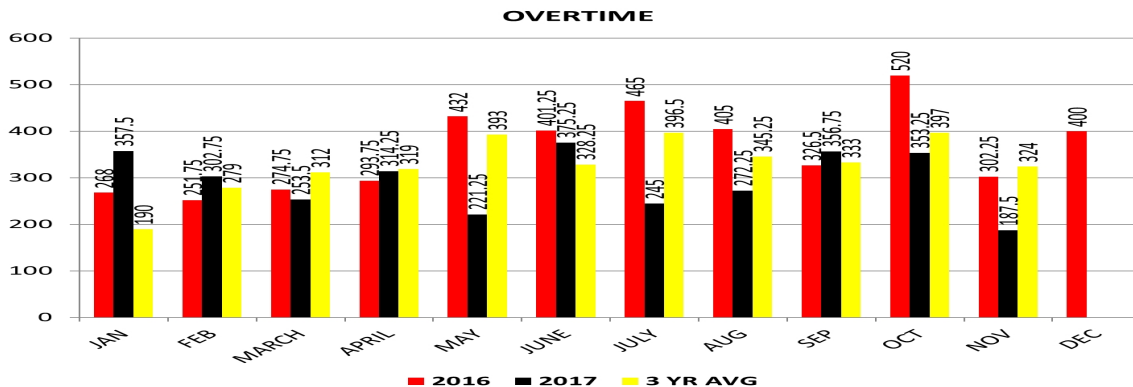
4.) ANTICIPATED PROJECTS/TASKS/ACTIVITIES
