- ◆ Part-Time Communications Officer Brooke Courtney began her tour of duty at the Hartford Police Department.

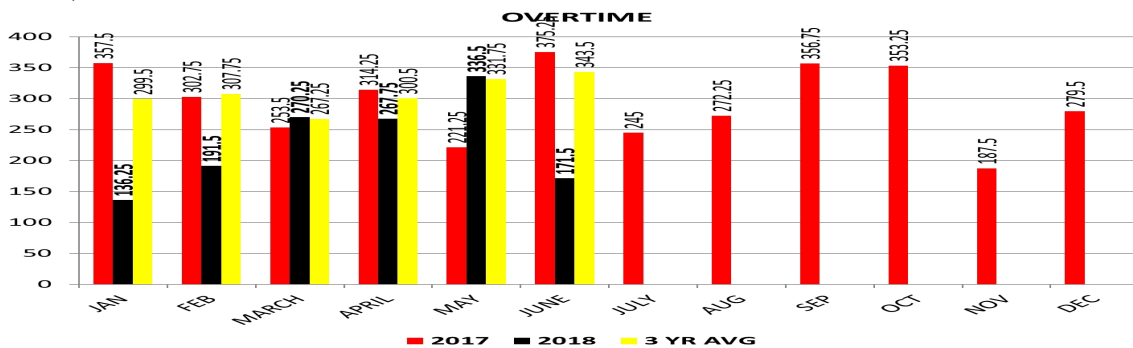
4.) ANTICIPATED PROJECTS/TASKS/ACTIVITIES
