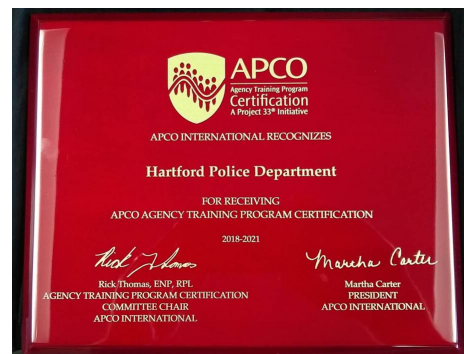
2.) CHIEF'S ACTIVITIES

- ◆ Police Aide Cole Parker began his tour of duty at the Hartford Police Department.

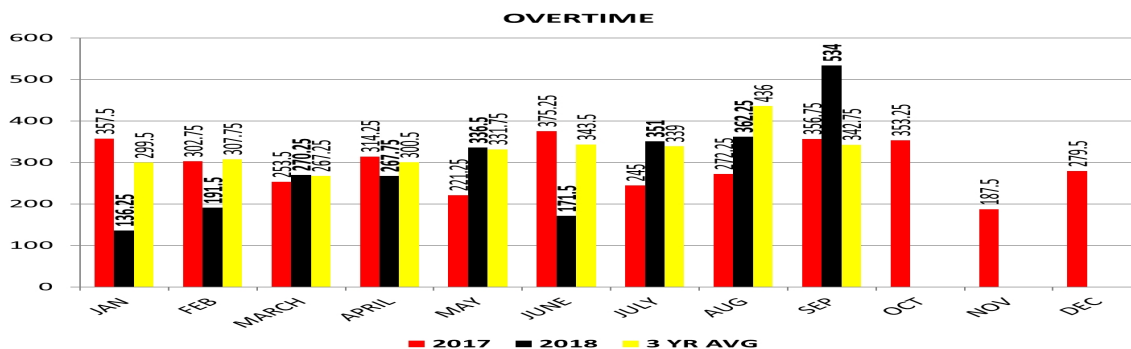
