## 4.) ANTICIPATED PROJECTS/TASKS/ACTIVITIES

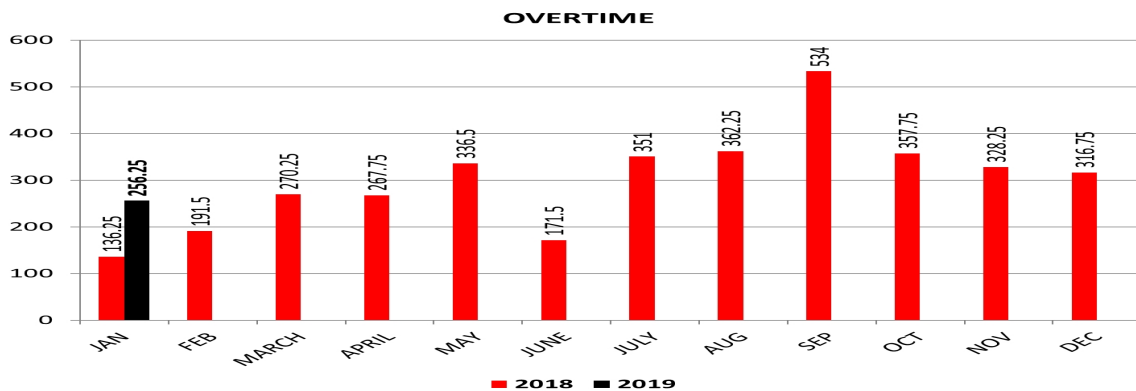
- ◆ The Communications Officer recruitment process will continue
