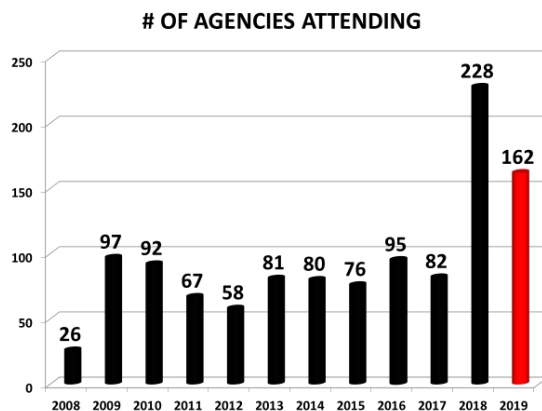
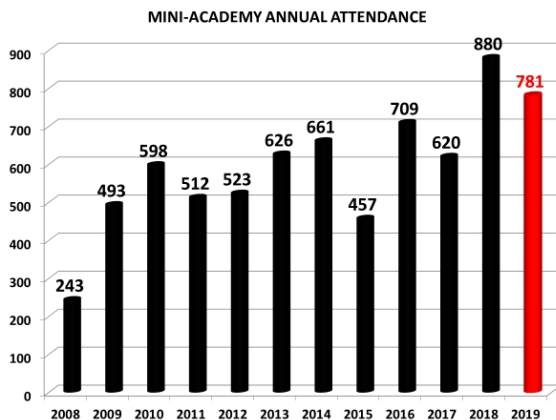

- ◆ Officer John Horter completed his Field Training and Evaluation Program and began solo patrol duties

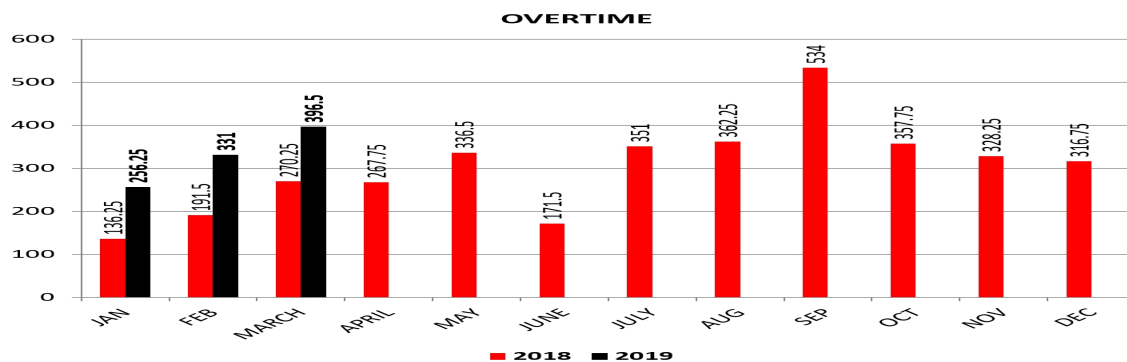
4.) ANTICIPATED PROJECTS/TASKS/ACTIVITIES
