- ◆ Communications Officers Snyder and Italiano presented the Question, Persuade, Refer (QPR) suicide recognition training for city staff

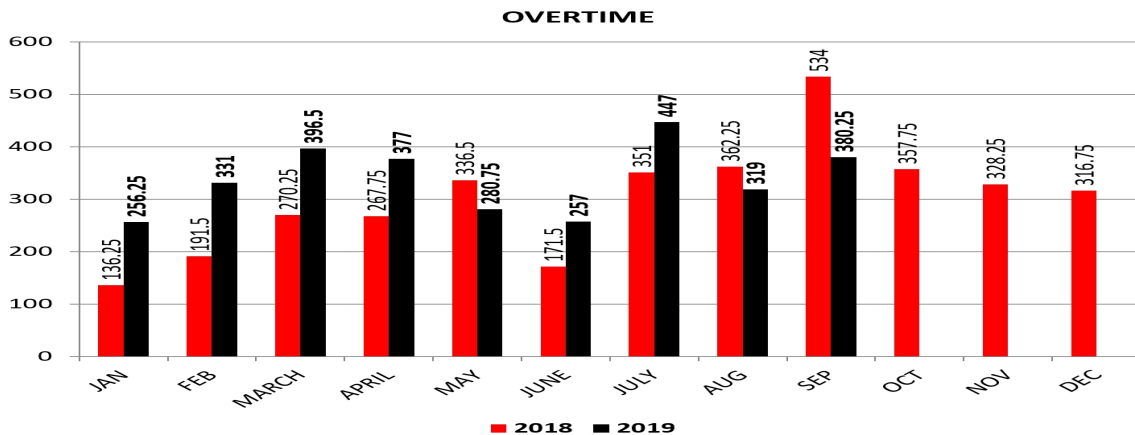
