- ◆ Capital Improvement Program budget approved

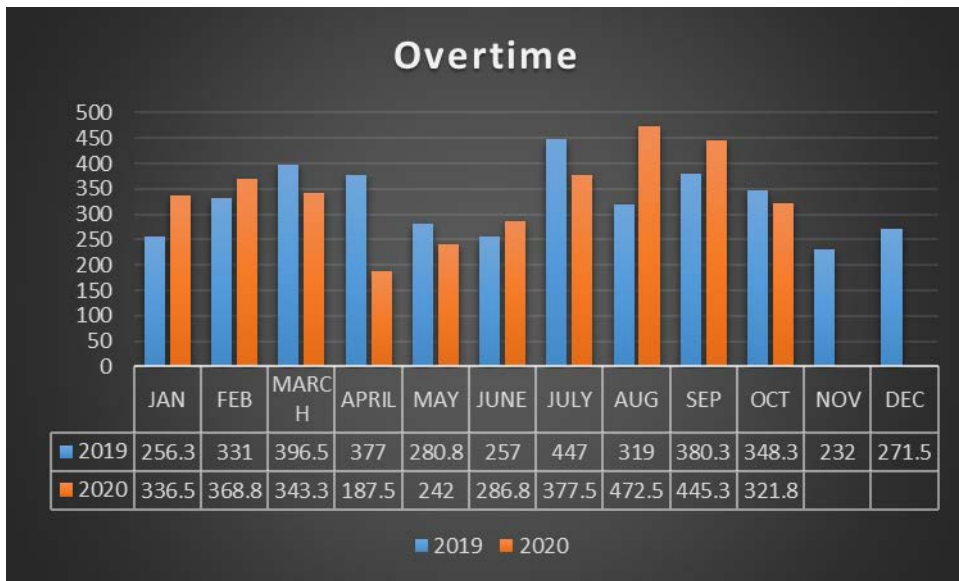
