- ◆ Awarded a citizen, and former Marine, for his rescue efforts for a man who went below the water on the Mill Pond



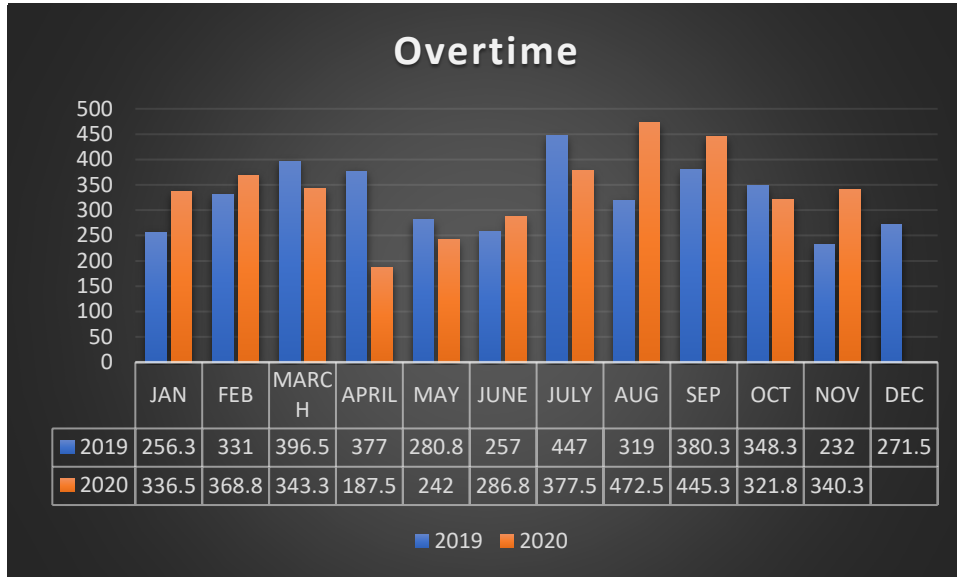
