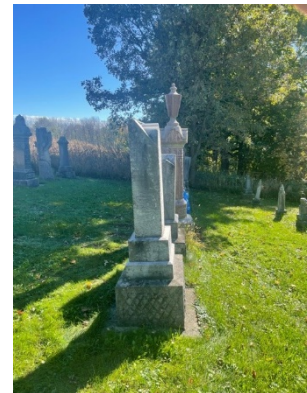

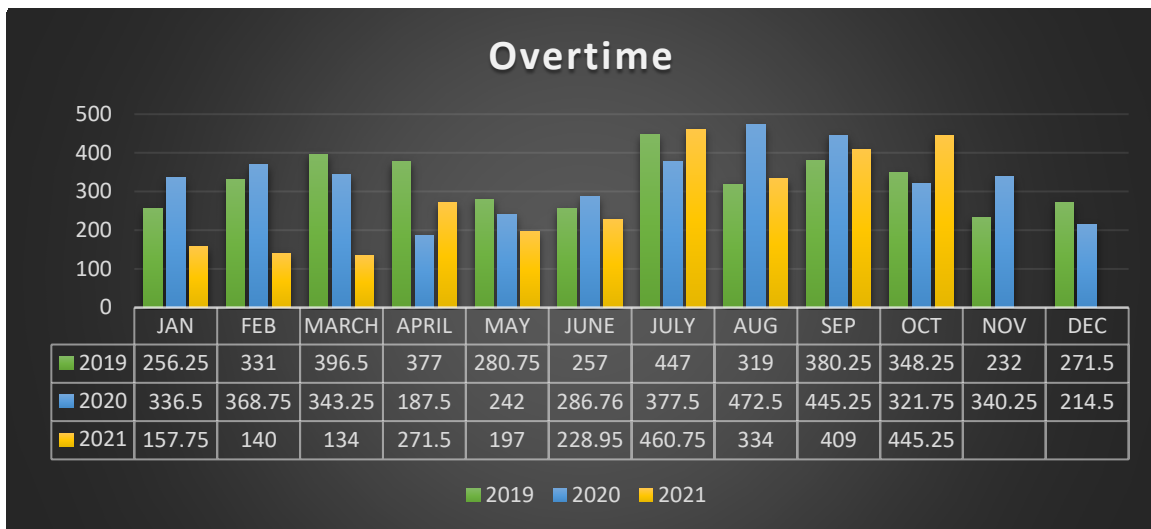

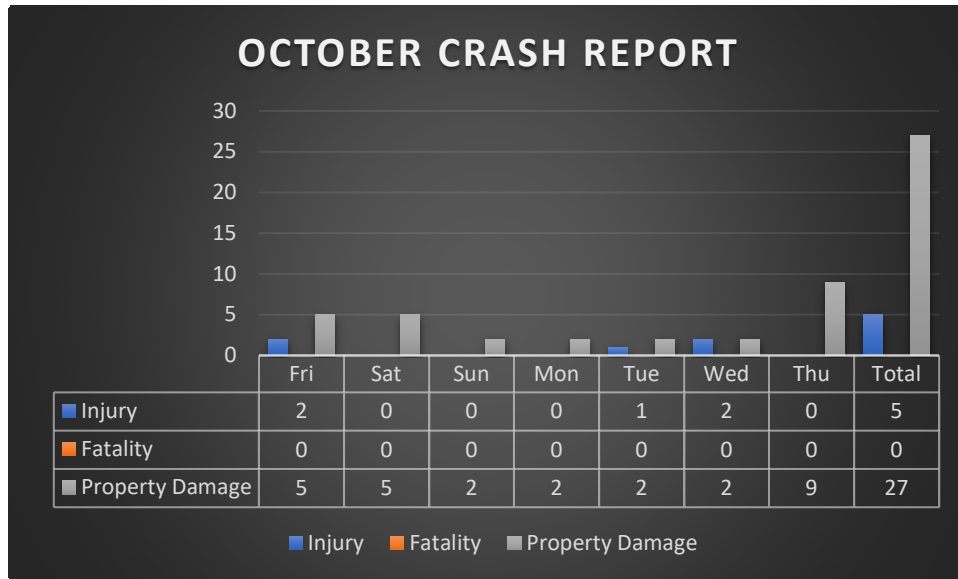

4.) **OVERTIME**



The month of October saw an increase in overtime ABOVE the previous year. That being said, dispatch overtime still accounted for just over half. We are working on training the newly hired dispatcher and expect her to be on her own soon. That should greatly reduce the overtime for December.

5.) **OCTOBER VEHICLE CRASH REPORT**



During the month of October, officers investigated forty fewer vehicular crash incidents than the previous month. Five one of those were personal injury related, and twenty seven property damage. They occurred on every day of the week with Thursday being significantly higher than other days for property damage related crashes.

6.) **USE OF FORCE INCIDENTS**

During the month of October, six use of force incidents were reported. One occurred during a traffic stop, one during a check welfare call, and four during routine responses to unlawful activity. During one of the incidents, it was necessary for the officer involved to display their firearm. In each of the incidents, the subject officers were interacting with failed to comply with verbal commands and so it became necessary to implement a control alternative to achieve and maintain control of resistive subjects.
