

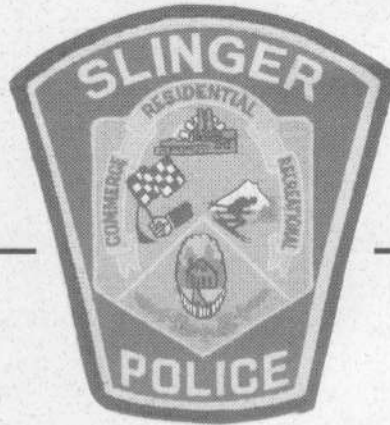

Dear Chief Groves,

On behalf of the Slinger Police Department, I wish to extend my personal thanks to you for the valuable assistance Officer Nate Dorn and K9 Officer Cash offered our department on two separate occasions recently.

On September 22, 2012 our services were requested by a family in the village who has some children dealing with drug issues. The parents requested a K9 search of their residence as two of their children had been involved in drug activity outside the home and the parents suspected they may be storing drugs within the home. Upon Officer Dorn and Officer K9 Cash searching the home more drugs were found, unfortunately from a third child of the homeowner. It is comforting to know that our closest neighboring police department is always more than willing to lend assistance, no matter the circumstance.

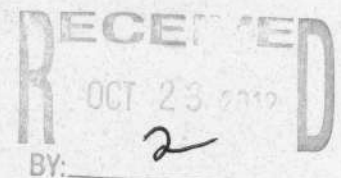
