



CURBSIDE GARBAGE PICK-UP

PLACEMENT OF REFUSE. Recyclables must be placed curbside by 7:00 am on your regular garbage day. No refuse may be placed at street curb line earlier than 2:00 pm on the day before scheduled pickup.

GARBAGE PACKAGING. All domestic garbage must be placed in the garbage cart provided by the City. No other garbage but that which fits into the cart WITH THE LID CLOSED will be picked up. No containers other than the City provided wheeled cart may be used for weekly curbside pickup.

FRIDAY EXCESSIVE GARBAGE PICKUP. Dispose of your large bulky, non-metal, items using the GREEN STICKERS you can purchase at the FINANCE counter on the top floor of City Hall. One Sticker per item. When purchasing the STICKERS place your address, list of items to dispose of, and phone number on the CLIPBOARD located to the right of the FINANCE counter on the wood pedestal. Call 673-8225 with questions.

A \$20.00 SOLID WASTE STICKER is required for each unit of non-metal large bulky refuse (SEE ATTACHED LIST with items listed - furniture, carpeting/padding, mattress/box spring set, recliner, etc.) Each item requires one (1) STICKER. The fee is payable at the FINANCE COUNTER on the top floor of City Hall, 109 North Main Street. Wood pieces will only be picked up if they are no longer than 4 feet and weigh no more than 50-60 pounds per bundle. Each bundle requires a STICKER. Remodeling refuse must be disposed of privately.

STICKERS CANNOT BE USED FOR APPLIANCES! **CURBSIDE PICKUP OF APPLIANCES** requires a pre-paid \$15 fee which is payable at the City FINANCE counter and then walk down to the Public Works counter (also located on the top floor of City Hall) to schedule your APPLIANCE pickup.

TV'S AND COMPUTER MONITORS. The City will accept TVs and Computer Monitors at the Recycling Center for a fee of \$25.00/TV or Monitor. ***This fee is subject to change if the contractor for the City increases the fee.*** The City charges the same fee to residents as it pays the contractor to pick up these electronics.

REMODELING REFUSE. Remodeling refuse must be disposed of privately. You can contact any private company that rents large dumpsters or the City's waste disposal contractor, Advanced Disposal Services, at 800-387-0949 with questions.

PAINT CANS. Leftover Latex and Oil-based PAINT can be disposed of by drying it out with an open lid or pouring the paint out in layers on newspaper, cardboard or kitty litter. Throw dried paint cans and dried paint material in your garbage containers. Aerosol paint cans are HAZARDOUS WASTE.

WEST BEND TRANSFER STATION. Residents may dispose of a truckload of garbage by hauling it to the Advanced Disposal Services garbage transfer station located at 803 N. River Road, West Bend. Charges are based on weight (Average minimum of \$55.00). Call the Transfer Station at 262-334-5618 with questions.
