### *What is Energy Assistance?*

The Energy Assistance Program provides qualified Washington County residents with a one-time annual payment to make energy (heating and electric) bills more affordable.

The funding pays a portion of energy costs, but the payment is not intended to cover the entire energy costs of a residence. The amount of the energy assistance payment varies depending on a variety of factors, including the household's size, income and energy costs. In most cases the energy assistance benefit is paid directly to the household's energy supplier.

### *When can you apply?*

You can apply between **October 1, 2019 - May 15, 2020**

### *Who is eligible to apply?*

Washington County households that are under 60% of the State Median income and have out-of-pocket energy costs.

### **What do I need to bring with me when I apply?**

- Photo ID (mandatory for first-time and NEW Washington County applicants)
- Social Security numbers and dates of birth for everyone in the household
- Current gas, electric or oil energy bill (or lease/letter from your landlord if heat is included in your rent)
- Proof of gross income for the entire household for the three months prior to the application month (child support, wages, pension, unemployment, etc.)


