2021 WINTER ADULT CO-ED & WOMENS VOLLEYBALL LEAGUE TEAM REGISTRATION INFORMATION

GENERAL INFORMATION

Co-Ed League on Monday nights. Women's League is on Wednesday nights. Games are scheduled between 6:15 – 9:15 PM. 2 divisions will be used if registrations allow. The A division is typically comprised of experienced teams which prefer power volleyball. The B division is made of teams that prefer a recreational approach to the game. Registration materials are available beginning October 26 (both leagues will NOT be officiated). A \$50 non-refundable deposit to hold a team spot can be taken beginning on that date. ALL REGISTRATION FEES & MATERIALS ARE DUE FRIDAY, DECEMBER 18th by 4:45 PM. There is NO captains meeting. LEAGUE PLAY BEGINS the week of January 4th and will run for approximately 8 weeks.

LEAGUE FEES

CO-ED: Team fee is \$75, \$20 refundable forfeit fee and a \$15 non-resident player fee for each non-resident player on roster. **WOMENS:** Team fee is \$75, \$20 refundable forfeit fee and a \$15 non-resident player fee for each non-resident player on roster.

ALL fees must be paid by 5:45 pm on Friday, December 18, registration deadline. A non-refundable \$50 deposit can be paid starting October 26 to hold your team's place in the league. Fees can be paid in cash, credit card and/or checks, from the sponsor and/or manager, and made payable to: *City of Hartford.*

TEAM REGISTRATION/PAYMENT FORM

This information is most important for placing your team in a league, mailing information to you, reaching you by phone in special circumstances and recording payments.

- 2. Team Name: Need for identification. If you do not have a sponsor when registering, list a name for identity. It can be changed prior to printing the schedules or during the season.
- 3. Captain's Name: Used for mailing and phone messages. List business extension numbers if applicable. Captain is responsible for player's eligibility.
- 4. League Played Last Year (if applicable)
- 5. Last Years Team Name: List if 50% or more of the team is returning.
- 6. Division requested: What league do you feel you can finish with a .500 winning percentage. Please don't rate yourself too low as it makes playing less enjoyable for those you defeat by large margins.

TEAM ROSTER

- 1. Captain must complete Player Roster.
- 2. Additional players may be added up until the 3rd week of league play. Thereafter, the captain must have approval of the Recreation Program Supervisor to add a player(s) to their roster.

PLAYER CARDS

Players must be 16 years of age or older and may play for only one team per league.

Managers are responsible for insuring that the following information is completed:

- 1. Name: Must have full first name, middle initial and last name.
- 2. Address/Phone: Must be the home address at which the player resides at the time they sign the card. Once a player moves out of the city limits of Hartford, they are considered a non-resident.
- 3. Player's Signature: Must be signed by the player. This signature means they have read the paragraph above the signature line. Any player under 18 must have their parent/guardian sign next to their signature.
- 4. Manager's Signature: Must be signed by the manager. The manager verifies and accepts responsibility for the players' eligibility.
- 5. Player cards must be turned into Hartford Parks and Recreation Office staff, during office hours, Monday Thursday, 7:00 AM 5:45 PM, Friday, 7:00 AM 4:45 PM. If applicable the non-resident player fee will be paid at that time.

NON-RESIDENT FEES

The Hartford Parks & Recreation Department operates by two primary financial sources - City property taxes and program/facility fees. Taxes pay for the majority of daily operations & maintenance, yearly capital projects and debts for large construction projects such as the Recreation Center. City Property Tax is paid whether or not an individual participates or uses the facilities of the Department. The non-resident fee concept is intended to apportion to non-residents an equalized fee so that they contribute to the overall financing of the Parks and Recreation Department.

To clarify, a City Resident is a person who pays City of Hartford Property Taxes AND votes at City Hall, the Recreation Center or the Hartford Library.
