On or about August 1, 2022 the UGLG will request the Division of Energy, Housing and Community Resources (DEHCR) to release Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds under Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 (PL 93-383), as amended, for this project.

The UGLG is certifying to DEHCR that it and its chief executive officer, in his or her official capacity as Mayor, City of Hartford, consent to accept the jurisdiction of the federal courts if an action is brought to enforce environmental review responsibilities, decision-making, and action; and that these responsibilities have been satisfied. Upon certification, UGLG may use the CDBG funds, and DEHCR will accept an objection to the release of funds and certification only if (a) the certification was not executed by the chief executive officer or other officer of UGLG approved by DEHCR; or (b) the UGLG's ERR indicates omissions of a required decision, finding or step. Objections must be prepared and submitted in accordance with 24 CFR 58, and may be addressed to the Division of Energy, Housing and Community Resources, Attention: Environmental Desk, P.O. Box 7970, Madison, WI 53707. Objections for reasons other than those stated above will not be considered by DEHCR. No objections received after August 19, 2022 will be considered by DEHCR.
